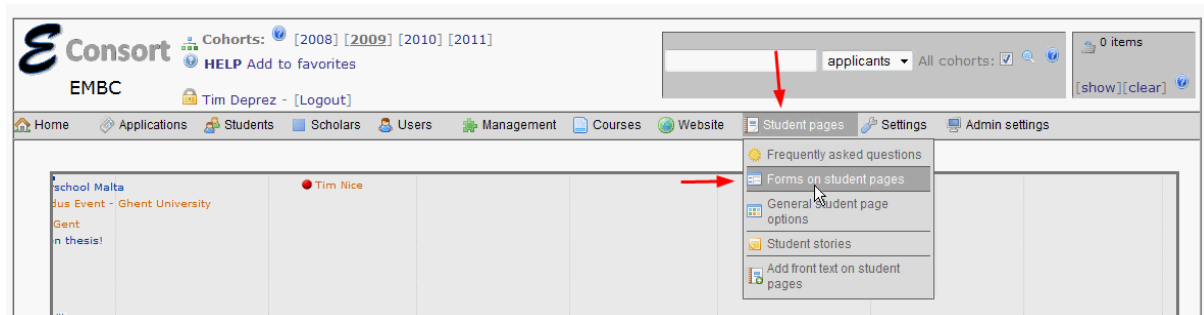
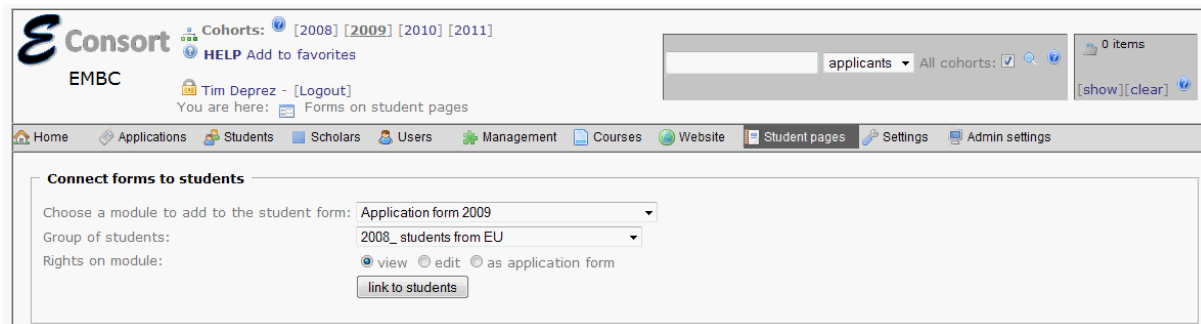


Connecting Forms to Student Pages



After choosing the student group, you can make 3 selections: “view”, “edit”, “as application form”.

By choosing “view”, students will not be allowed to change any data (but they are able to ask permission to change certain data) i.e. The student want to change his nationality, after they entered it, you will get a request to allow the change.

By choosing “edit”, students will be allowed to change data.

By choosing “as application form”, students will be able to enter data in the form, and same as with application forms, after they entered all obligatory fields, the student will be able to submit this form.

By clicking “Link to students”, you can link your preselected choices to a group of students, in this case “evaluation _2010_EU” In this group, there are 7 students. By clicking on the list

name, you open the list of students involved, and in that list the “rights” of the students are shown. Which in this case are –by default– set as view only
